Second, buy a World Tour Book. It's a great way to show your children, grandchildren, family and friends where you served and the places you traveled while on the USS Belknap.


As always, I am grateful to the Board and Past Presidents for their advice and support. It's an honor to be part of this special group and to have fun while preserving our legacy.


USS Belknap Association History




We intend to make the jackets available through the Ship's Store, so if want something special, send our Storekeeper Lou Apuzzo a note and he'll try to get it for you.



I found a newsletter article written in 2014 by one of our founders, the late Dick Lemon. He described meeting with Master Chief Al Sniff right after the Belknap's decommissioning ceremony in 1995. They spoke of how the spirit of the Belknap

lives on through its collective crews over the years. Plans were made to contact former shipmates and see if there was interest in having an association and yearly reunions.

They found many enthusiastic shipmates, such as our first president Jim Farrow. They also found a very special shipmate, an officer who was first XO and later CO: Captain Dick Shafer enthusiastically embraced the USS Belknap Association and faithfully attended our first 19 reunions, from 2002 until his death in 2020. He was an inspiration to all of us who knew him.

As we prepare for our October reunion in North Myrtle Beach, SC, we are grieving the loss of another founding father, Al Sniff. Al was a WWII veteran and our Association's "ancient mariner." With a Navy career that ran from the 1940's to his retirement in the mid 1970's, he was always one to "snap ya" with sailor humor or share a sea story. The Association embraced Al's late wife, and his daughters who accompanied him in later years. If any of you have special memories of Master Chief Sniff, we plan to have a special memorial tribute to him at the reunion. 
